#### After-School Format

The heart of our program is a one-hour group riding lesson. We work with all riding levels. Children can also observe horse training, horse care, study or do barn chores. The program is offered Tuesday through Thursday. Your child may participate one, two or three days of the week.

Hours are from 3:00 until 6:00.

#### Individual Needs of Each Child

We are honored to work closely with parents and teachers to address the individual needs of each child.

- Schoolwork always comes first. Do you want us to check to see if homework has been done before your child rides?
- Does your child need help with his/her homework?

#### Transportation

We may be able to provide *limited* transportation to the barn from some area schools, including Lake Carolina Elementary, Kelly Mill Middle, and Blythewood Middle. First, check with your friends about car pooling!

#### Rates

Monthly rates are based upon the number of days/week attended. If your child comes once/week, it is \$150/mo; twice/week = \$250/mo; three times/week = \$350/mo.
